- Winners will be announced April 1, 2026.
- Winners and one guest will receive complimentary tickets to attend Chi Pi Zeta’s Scholarship Awards Night event to be held on April 25, 2026. Additional tickets will be available for purchase.

- Graduating High School Senior from Liberty County High School, Bradwell Institute, and Richmond Hill High School.


